

Meeting with the Chair of the British-Uzbek Society



On March 16th 2018 ISRS held the meeting with the head of the British-Uzbek Society, leading British scientist on Central Asia Shirin Akiner.

During the meeting, two sides discussed the prospects for bilateral cooperation between Uzbekistan and United Kingdom. The Uzbek side draw attention of British expert to the large scale of dynamic reforms and transformations in political, social, economical and other spheres in the framework of “The Strategy of Action in 2017-2021”, as well as to the initiatives of the President of Uzbekistan, announced during the Astana Summit of the OIC.
