

Meeting at the Turkish think tank “ANKASAM”

On November 14, with the assistance of the Embassy of the Republic of Uzbekistan in Ankara, a scientific seminar was organized between the ISMI under the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Center for crises and political studies of Turkey (ANKASAM). During the event, participants discussed the ongoing processes in the Islamic world, initiatives of Uzbek President Shavkat Mirziyoyev on promoting of enlightened Islam, as well as issues of development of cooperation between ISRS and ANKASA.

Underlining the critical importance of these initiatives, as well as the enormous intellectual heritage of Uzbekistan, the head of ANKASAM, Professor Mehmet Erol, stressed the need to implement joint research projects to popularize enlightened Islam, conceptual and theoretical foundations of which were laid by world-famous Islamic scholars, such as Al Bukhari, Imam Moturidi, Naqshbandi and others.
