

Flags raised at the new building of the Turkic Council Secretariat



On November 12, the Flags Raising Ceremony took place at the new building of the Secretariat of the Turkic Council, in the city of Istanbul.

The ceremony was attended by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev with the heads of the fraternal states.

Flags of Uzbekistan, Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkey, as well as Hungary, Turkmenistan and the organization itself were raised in a solemn atmosphere.
