
Uzbekistan, Iran Presidents discuss promising areas of mutually beneficial cooperation



President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev met with the President of the Islamic Republic of Iran Ebrahim Raisi within the framework of the events of the next Summit of the Economic Cooperation Organization, in Turkmenistan's Ashqabat.

Issues of further development of mutually beneficial relations between the two countries were discussed.

The implementation of new cooperation projects in industry, the effective use of the transit potential of the two states and the promotion of cultural-humanitarian exchange programs, the importance of activating institutional mechanisms of cooperation was emphasized to promote increasing the volume of bilateral trade.
