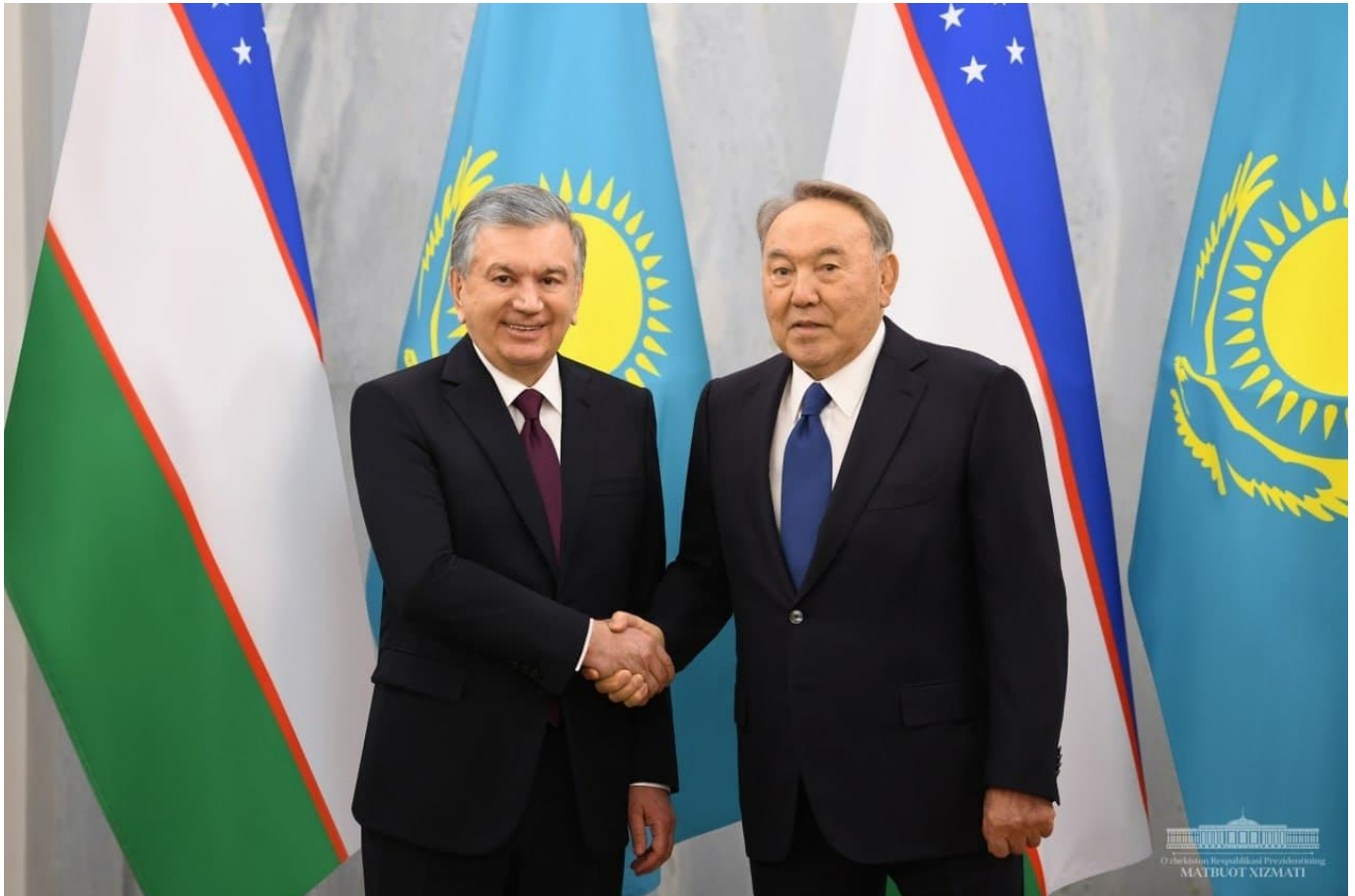


Shavkat Mirziyoyev meets with Nursultan Nazarbayev



Following the high-level talks, President Shavkat Mirziyoyev met with the First President of the Republic of Kazakhstan – Elbasy Nursultan Nazarbayev.

The President of Uzbekistan cordially congratulated him on the First President’s Day, which is celebrated on the first day of December in recognition of the outstanding merits of the founder of independent Kazakhstan.
