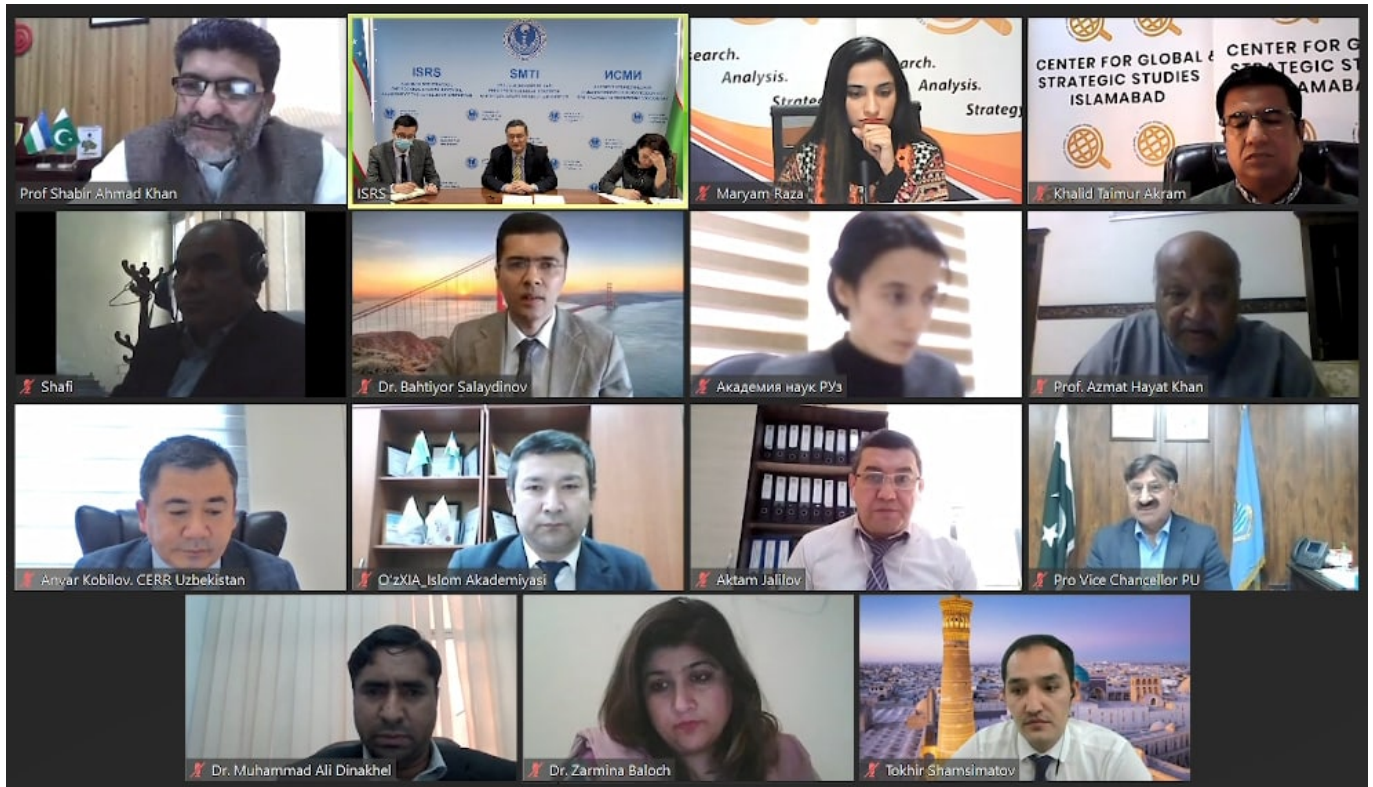


Uzbek-Pakistani cooperation in the field of education can become an important factor in strengthening bilateral humanitarian ties



Such an assessment was shared by the Vice-Rector of the Punjab University, Dr. Mazhar Salim, during the Uzbek-Pakistani online conference on February 15, 2022.

According to the Pakistani professor, such areas of research as oriental studies, natural sciences and business economics are of great interest among students of both Pakistan and Uzbekistan.

In this regard, the Pakistani scientist believes that the development and promotion of educational programs not only among students of higher educational institutions of the two countries, but also educators, will help expand contacts. “Extensive work is being carried out at the Punjab University to attract foreign students, including from Uzbekistan, to educational exchanges”, he stressed.
