

ISRS hosted a meeting with representatives of the international non-governmental organization “Regional Dialogue”



On March 14 this year at the Institute for Strategic and Regional Studies under the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan (ISRS), a meeting was held with representatives of the international non-governmental organization (INGO) “Regional Dialogue” – executive director Katya Gershak and deputy head of the branch in Uzbekistan Bekzod Sharipov.
