**Focus On Strategic Partnership With Foreign Nations To Modernize Economy: Uzbek President**

Uzbekistan's foreign policy is the formation of a balanced system of strategic partnership and cooperation with the world's leading states and international organizations. This approach is designed to provide an effective solution to the tasks of modernizing the economy, maintaining stability and security, and creating favorable conditions for cooperation in Central Asia. The President also paid great attention to the development of science using foreign experience and the establishment of cooperation with foreign universities and research centers.

The strategic partnership of Uzbekistan with the United States of America has reached a qualitatively new level, developing faster steadily and preferentially on the basis of the principles of equality, mutual respect, trust, and consideration of each other's interests. Relations of Uzbekistan with Egypt, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Kuwait, Qatar, Oman, Bahrain, Jordan, Algeria, and other Middle Eastern countries are reaching a fundamentally new level. It should be noted that the development and strengthening of mutually beneficial and comprehensive relations with the states of the Middle East remains one of the priorities of Uzbekistan's foreign policy.

Using the potential of international platforms, Uzbekistan pays special attention to strengthening trade ties and mutually beneficial cooperation with the countries of the Commonwealth of Independent States. In his address to the City Magistrate last week, speaking about the strategy of the country's first anniversary in the CIS in 2020, the President of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev noted: "We will use all opportunities to expand economic cooperation in the Commonwealth, increase the effectiveness of the decisions made by the organization and further strengthen humanitarian ties between the participating countries".

As of today, Uzbekistan has raised the level of its bilateral cooperation in the CIS form deputy foreign minister to Deputy Prime Minister and resumed its participation in the CIS Economic Council.

The agenda of Uzbekistan's cooperation with international financial institutions includes improving the investment and business climate, fostering the country's credit rating, improving monetary policy, qualifications of national specialists in the banking and financial sector.

The ultimate goal is to increase the volume of attracted foreign investments and financial resources to accelerate modernization and enhance the

Maqolada O'zbekistonning tashqi siyosati dunyoning yetakchi davlatlari va xalqaro tashkilotlari bilan strategik sheriklik va hamkorlikning muvozanatli tizimi ekani ta'kidlangan. Ushbu yondashuv iqtisodiyotni modernizatsiya qilish, barqarorlik va xavfsizlikni ta'minlash, Markaziy Osiyoda hamkorlik uchun qulay sharoit yaratish bo'yicha vazifalarni samarali hal etish uchun mo'ljallangani bildiriladi. Prezident chet el tajribasidan foydalangan holda ilm-fanni rivojlantirishga, xorijiy universitetlar va ilmiy markazlar bilan hamkorlik aloqalarini o'rnatishga katta e'tibor qaratayotgani qayd etiladi.

Bundon tashqari, muallif O'zbekistonning AQSH bilan strategik sheriklik hamkorlik darajasi tenglik, o'zaro hurmat, ishonch va o'zaro manfaatlarni hisobga olish tamoyillari asosida izchil rivojlanib borayotgani sifat jihatidan yangi bosqichga ko'tarilganini ma'lum qiladi.

Muallif ta'kidlaganidek, O'zbekistonning Misr, Saudiya Arabistoni, Birlashgan Arab Amirliklari, Kuvayt, Qatar, O'mon, Bahrayn, Iordaniya, Jazoir va boshqa Yaqin Sharq mamlakatlari bilan aloqalari yangi bosqichga ko'tarilmoqda. Yaqin Sharq davlatlari bilan o'zaro manfaatli va har tomonlama aloqalarni rivojlantirish, uni mustahkamlash O'zbekiston tashqi siyosatining ustuvor yo'nalishlaridan biri bo'lib qolmoqda.

«O'zbekiston xalqaro salohiyatdan foydalanib, Mustaqil Davlatlar Hamdo'stligi mamlakatlari bilan do'stona aloqalarni va o'zaro manfaatli hamkorlikni mustahkamlashga alohida e'tibor qaratmoqda», deb yoziladi jurnaldagi maqolada.

Muallif O'zbekiston Markaziy Osiyoda asosiy davlat ekani va alohida o'rin tutishini ta'kidlaydi. Mamlakatning mintaqadagi ahamiyati xorijiy ekspert va siyosiy doiralar tomonidan ham tan olingan. Toshkent mintaqaning barcha qo'shni davlatlari bilan strategik sheriklik ta'g'risida shartnomalar imzoladi, bu esa mintaqaviy siyosatni yuqori darajada olib borishga imkon beradi. Shu maqsadda olib borilayotgan ishlar mamlakatimizning xalqaro munosabatlar tizimidagi o'rni va rolini kuchaytirishda ham muhimdir.

Maqolada qayd etilishicha, rasmiy Toshkent hamkorlikni rivojlantirish bo'yicha tashabbuslarni ilgari surish orqali biror yo'nalishda yetakchilikni qo'lga kiritishni da'vo qilmaydi, aksincha O'zbekiston tashabbuslari barcha mamlakatlar manfaatlarini hisobga oladi va konsensus tamoyilga asoslanadi.
