and equity, address the security needs of those of working, address language barriers and honour the diversity and contributions of Indian-Americans. This is the first time that a Democratic presidential candidate has come out with an inclusive policy document for Indian-Americans. There are 1.3 million eligible Indian-American voters across eight battleground states.

Biden will support family-based immigration and prevent family unification as a core principle of our immigration system, which includes reducing the family visa backlog. His campaign said: "We will reverse the paid giant attention to the development of science using foreign experience and the establishment of cooperation with foreign universities and research centers."

The strategic partnership of Uzbekistan with the United States of America has reached a qualitatively new level, developing faster steadily and preferentially on the basis of the principles of equality, mutual respect, trust, and consideration of each other's interests. Relations of Uzbekistan with Egypt, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Kuwait, Qatar, Oman, Bahrain, Jordan, Algeria, and other Middle Eastern countries are reaching a fundamentally new level. It should be noted that the development and strengthening of mutually beneficial and comprehensive relations with the states of the Middle East remains one of the priorities of Uzbekistan's foreign policy.

Using the potential of international platforms, Uzbekistan pays special attention to strengthening steady and mutually beneficial cooperation with the members of the Commonwealth of Independent States. In his address to the City Hall last week, speaking about the strategy of the country's first anniversary in the CIS in 2020, the President of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev noted: "We will use all opportunities to expand economic cooperation in the Commonwealth, increase the effectiveness of the decisions made by the organization and further strengthen humanitarian ties between the participating states."

As of today, Uzbekistan has raised the level of its bilateral cooperation in the CIS term deputy foreign minister in Deputy Prime Minister and resumed its participation in the CIS Economic Council.

The agenda of Uzbekistan's cooperation with international financial institutions includes improving the investment and business climate, fostering the country's credit rating, improving monetary policy, qualifications of national specialists in the banking and financial sector.

The ultimate goal is to increase the volume of attracted foreign investments and financial resources to accelerate modernization and enhance the

Ҳиндистонда инглиз тилида нашр этиладиган "Political Events» журналида «Ўзбекистон Президенти: иқтисодий модернизация қилиш учун хорижий давлатлар билан стратегик шерикликка урғу» сарлавҳали мақола чоп этилди, деб хабар бермоқда «Дунё» АА муҳбири.

Мақолада Ўзбекистоннинг ташқи сиёсати дунёнинг етакчи давлатлари ва халқаро ташкилотлари билан стратегик шериклик ва ҳамкорликнинг мувозанатли тизими экани таъкидланган. Ушбу ёндашув иқтисодий модернизация қилиш, барқарорлик ва хавфсизликни таъминлаш, Марказий Осиёда ҳамкорлик учун қулай шароит яратиш бўйича вазифаларни самарали ҳал этиш учун мўлжалланган билдирилади. Президент чет эл тажрибасидан фойдаланган ҳолда илм-фанни ривожлантиришга, хорижий университетлар ва илмий марказлар билан ҳамкорлик алоқаларини ўрнатишга катта эътибор қаратаётгани қайд этилади.

Бундан ташқари, муаллиф Ўзбекистоннинг АҚШ билан стратегик шериклик ҳамкорлик даражаси тенглик, ўзаро ҳурмат, ишонч ва ўзаро манфаатларни ҳисобга олиш тамойиллари асосида изчил ривожланиб бораётгани сифат жиҳатидан янги босқичга кўтарилганини маълум қилади.

Муаллиф таъкидлаганидек, Ўзбекистоннинг Миср, Саудия Арабистони, Бирлашган Араб Амириклари, Кувайт, Қатар, Ўмон, Баҳрайн, Иордания, Жазоир ва бошқа Яқин Шарқ мамлакатлари билан алоқаларни янги босқичга кўтарилмоқда. Яқин Шарқ давлатлари билан ўзаро манфаатли ва ҳар томонлама алоқаларни ривожлантириш, уни мустаҳкамлаш Ўзбекистон ташқи сиёсатининг устувор йўналишларидан бири бўлиб қолмоқда.

«Ўзбекистон халқаро салоҳиятдан фойдаланиб, Мустақил Давлатлар Ҳамдўстлиги мамлакатлари билан дўстона алоқаларни ва ўзаро манфаатли ҳамкорликни мустаҳкамлашга алоҳида эътибор қаратмоқда», деб ёзилади журналдаги мақолада.

Муаллиф Ўзбекистон Марказий Осиёда асосий давлат экани ва алоҳида ўрин тутишини таъкидлайди. Мамлакатнинг минтақадаги аҳамияти хорижий эксперт ва сиёсий доиралар томонидан ҳам тан олинган. Тошкент минтақанинг барча қўшни давлатлари билан стратегик шериклик тўғрисида шартномалар имзолади, бу эса минтақавий сиёсатни юқори даражада олиб

боришга имкон беради. Шу мақсадда олиб борилаётган ишлар мамлакатимизнинг халқаро муносабатлар тизимидаги ўрни ва ролини кучайтиришда ҳам муҳимдир.

Мақолада қайд этилишича, расмий Тошкент ҳамкорликни ривожлантириш бўйича ташаббусларни илгари суриш орқали бирор йўналишда етакчиликни қўлга киритишни даъво қилмайди, аксинча Ўзбекистон ташаббуслари барча мамлакатлар манфаатларини ҳисобга олади ва консенсус тамойилга асосланади.

«Political Events» журналида чоп этилган мақола охирида Марказий Осиё давлатлари ўртасида маданий-гуманитар соҳадаги яқин ҳамкорликни, дўстлик ва яхши қўшничилик муносабатларини мустаҳкамлаш ва кенгайтиришга алоҳида эътибор қаратилмоқда.
